

RELEASE FROM REJECTION AND GRIEF

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1. Jesus suffered rejection.
Is 53:3 "He is despised and rejected of men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief..... He was despised and we did not esteem Him."
Jn 1:11 "He came to His own and His own did not receive Him"
Jn 19:15 "But they cried out, 'away with Him, away with Him, crucify Him!'"
2. Rejection is quite often experienced by those who turn to follow Christ.
Mat 10:36 Jesus said, "a man's foes shall be those of his own household."
1Jn 3:13 "Do not marvel, my brethren if the world hates you."
Jn 15:18 Jesus said, "if the world hates you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you."
3. Rejection can cause deep hurt and grief especially when it comes from someone with whom we have had a close relationship and friendship. Rejection is the root cause of many spiritual, mental and physical problems.
4. Rejection is experienced when those from whom we expect to receive love, encouragement, and support, "turn their back on us," neglect, abuse or hurt us.
5. As an example: A mother struggles to bring up her children with maybe little help from her husband. Perhaps, when the children reach teenage years, the mother still tries to hold them close to herself, with the result that they forcibly draw away to seek to establish their own identity and independence. This often results in the mother suffering grief and rejection from her teenage children for whom she has sacrificed a great deal and who mean everything to her. The result of this rejection and grief can cause deep inward hurt, tension, stress, with various physical symptoms of pains and aches and emotional upset. As a result, in relationship with other people, there is often withdrawal, whenever the threat of possible rejection occurs, to avoid further hurt and grief.
6. The problem of rejection can sometimes be compounded by **evil spirits** that reinforce rejection, especially where the person who suffered rejection, has reacted with any bitterness, resentment or unforgiveness. Also, at times there can be a curse of rejection in operation that has been established in the family line, perhaps several generations previously. For example: a mother of a previous generation who has been rejected by her daughter, may say to her, "One day you'll suffer for the way you are treating me!" This is of the nature of a curse, and it may come from someone, who without realising it, is trying to control her daughter as she grows to adulthood. When the daughter has children, the curse of rejection continues to operate and causes continuing problems unless it is recognised and revoked.
7. **Now praise God with all our heart, that He, through Jesus Christ has provided a total solution to rejection and grief, evil spirit influence and every curse, so that we may become completely free and released to the peace and blessing of God in every relationship and family.**
8. **At the Cross Jesus took our rejection and gave us His acceptance and high favour with God, Eph 1:3,4,5,6.**
Eph 1:6 By His grace He has made us **accepted in the Beloved**, (that is Christ). See KJV, NKJV.
 Note that in *Lk 1:28* the Greek word translated "highly favoured" one, is the same as that translated 'accepted' in *Eph 1:6*. In Jesus we are accepted and highly favoured. Daily confess your total release from rejection and grief through Jesus Christ, and your total acceptance and high favour with God. Rejection will not control and ruin your life in Jesus' Name.

If there are evil spirits reinforcing rejection and its evil effects, (or if no evil spirits are involved at all), repent and be cleansed in Jesus' Blood from all resentment, bitterness and unforgiveness towards those people who caused the rejection. **(Release those who have caused the rejection from your judgment. Mat 7:1,2, Rom 2:1,2, Jam 4:11,12. To be released and healed from rejection, also forgive and bless them as Jesus has told us, Mk 11:25,26, Lk 6:27,28,35-37.)** Submit to Jesus as Lord, if evil spirits of rejection are involved, resist the evil spirits of rejection and their associates and command them to flee, *Jam 4:7*. Receive the Holy Spirit of grace to fill you with the life, liberty and love of God.

If there has been a curse of rejection established in your family, by words spoken by one generation towards another, take authority in Jesus' Name and break the curse. ***Gal 3:13,14* clearly says that Jesus has taken the curse of the law, of every judgment against us, and has loosed us to receive the full blessing of God, Is 54:17, Rom 8:33,34.** Revoke the curse in Jesus' Name and release the blessing of God that He has provided for us through His Son, *Eph 1:3*.

We have been made the righteousness of God in Christ, *Phil 3:9*. He (Christ), was made to be sin for us, who knew no sin, that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him, *2Cor 5:21*.
