

The Tide of Righteousness Has Turned and Is Coming In

“The Lord has come to New Zealand”

Isaiah 45:8

From September 27th to October 3rd, 2012, the Holy Spirit continued to speak to me, very strongly, from Isaiah 51:1 to 52:12, and from Zechariah 9:11-17, and Isaiah 59:19 to 60:5.

As I read and read these passages, the Holy Spirit open my spiritual eyes to see that there has been a turnaround in the spiritual realm, which will transform New Zealand society for the glory of God.

At 4am on October 3rd, the Lord called my name and I awoke. I said, “What are You saying Lord?” The Lord said, “Get up.” So I got dressed and went into the kitchen. I asked the Lord, “What are You saying Lord?” He replied, “I am going to do something.” I asked what that was? He did not reply. After a few seconds I burst out singing, “*Joy to the world, the Lord has come, Let earth receive her King, Let every heart prepare Him room, Let heaven and nature sing.*” I had not sung that song for a long time. It was many years before, that I heard the Lord call my name.

Isaiah 51:1 to 52:12.

V1 and 2, God calls attention to **those who pursue righteousness and seek the Lord**, to look to where they have come from, the Rock, Jesus, Ephesians 2:20, and the pit, Psalm 40:2, and to look to their spiritual, faith heritage in Abraham and Sarah. The Lord chose this couple and through them created a mighty nation.

V3, **These He calls Zion.** “For the Lord shall comfort Zion.” The Lord comforts us by pouring out His Spirit on us. John 14:16,17,18,26,27. The Lord is pouring out His Spirit on Zion, His people, Hebrews 12:22-24, Galatians 4:26, and making all their waste, wilderness, and desert places into a beautiful garden.

The Holy Spirit gave Dorothy a vision of this garden, on 3.12.79, at a Church home group in Papakura, New Zealand, and it was very beautiful.

V4, God calls attention to His people, Zion, His nation, because **He is sending out a law of justice, or fairness**, which will bring light or revelation and truth throughout New Zealand. The Lord requires justice for the poor, the widows, the orphans, the homeless, the unborn and many others. Those people who have been living by injustice, corruption, fraud, overcharging, lies, extortion, **will rise in anger against this new law of justice** and those who stand for it. There will be considerable conflict.

V5, The Lord draws attention to His righteousness and salvation, and does so in V6,V7,V8 as well.

His arms will bring judgment upon the people who wish to continue in their unjust ways, but some of those who dwell in the coastlands shall embrace the Lord’s law of justice and wait upon the Lord and trust on His arm.

The arm of the Lord is the Messiah, the Lord Jesus Christ. See Isaiah 53:1-5.

V6, His judgment shall result in changes and upsets in the heavens, (weather problems), and in the earth, (quakes), but His righteousness and salvation shall stand firm. (See Isaiah 51:16).

V7, **While the judgments of the Lord are taking place**, the righteous, who carry the law of the Lord in their hearts, are encouraged not to fear the reproach or the revilings of the ungodly or the unrighteous.

V8, The ungodly shall vanish away, but the righteousness of the Lord and His salvation shall stand for ever.

V9, The righteous cry, “Arise, arise, O arm of the Lord, are You not He that smote Egypt, (Rahab-a symbol of the world), and wounded the serpent?” This is a cry to Jesus, Who is the arm of the Lord. Isaiah 53:1.

Jesus smote Egypt and wounded the serpent in the past, in the land of Egypt, Exodus 12:29, and at Calvary.

John 16:33, John 12:31, Hebrews 2:14, Colossians 2:15, 1John 3:8.

V10, “Are You not He that parted the sea and made a way for Your redeemed people to crossover from Egypt to the wilderness?” Exodus 14:22.

V11, The redeemed of the Lord shall return to Zion with great joy and gladness.

V12,13,14,15, The Lord is pouring out His Spirit of comfort on Zion, John 14:26, the Comforter, and exhorts His people not to be afraid of the fury of the people who seek to oppress the righteous. The Lord says, “I am the Lord your God, that divided the sea: The Lord of armies is His name.”

V16, I have put My words in your mouth, and I have covered you with the shadow of My hand, that I may establish the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, “You are My people.” pto

V17,18,19,20,21, Jerusalem is the wider city around Zion. Many in Jerusalem are less committed to the Lord than those in Zion. Isaiah 51:1,2,7. For this reason the Lord’s fury is upon them, V17, the fury of His rebuke. V20. The comfort of the Lord, the Comforter, His Holy Spirit, is not being poured out upon Jerusalem at this time. In time, the fury of the Lord’s rebuke is effective, and things change for the better.

V22,23, As the fury of the Lord's rebuke becomes effective, the cup of trembling is taken out of the hand of those who live in Jerusalem and is put into the hands of those that have been afflicting them.

Isaiah 52:1-12.

V1,2, Arise Zion and put on your strength. Arise Jerusalem and put on your beautiful garments. Arise and be free from every hindrance.

V3,4,5, You have sold yourselves to be slaves of the oppressors, but you will be redeemed. You cannot serve Me while you are slaves of evil task masters.

V6, Therefore My people will know My name, "I Am". Exodus 3:14,15.

V7, And they will go forth in great authority to win the lost.

V8, The watchmen, intercessors, leaders will be as one, as the Lord redeems Zion. Psalm 126.

V9, Jerusalem is filled with joy as the Holy Spirit, the Comforter, is poured out, and Jerusalem is redeemed.

V10, The Holy Arm of the Lord, Jesus, Isaiah 53:1, is revealed to the ends of the earth as the salvation of our God.

V11, Be separate from the world's system and be clean as you serve God.

V12, The Lord will go before you and behind you.

Zechariah 9:11-17.

V11, By the blood of Jesus, 1Corinthians 11:25, we have been sent forth out of the waterless pit.

V12, As we turn to the stronghold of hope, the Lord says, "Even today I give you the double inheritance,"

Deuteronomy 21:17, of the First born Son, Jesus. Colossians 1:15,18.

The double blessing for the believer is water baptism and the baptism with the Holy Spirit. Galatians 3:27, Acts 1:5,8.

In water baptism we are baptized into Christ, Galatians 3:27, Romans 6:3, 2Corinthians 5:17, and in baptism with the Holy Spirit we receive the power of God to enable us to serve Him. Acts 1:4,5,8, Luke 24:49.

V13, For I have bent Judah, praise, as My bow. I have filled the bow with the arrow of Ephraim, fruitfulness.

I have raised up your sons, O Zion, against the sons of Greece, the humanists, and I have made you sons of Zion, as the sword of a mighty man.

V14, The Lord is seen over His sons of Zion. The Lord's arrow of fruitfulness flies as lightning.

The Lord blows the trumpet of advance and goes with the tornadoes of the south.

V15, The Lord of Hosts defends the sons of Zion, and they devour and subdue as with sling stones, in the way David did with Goliath. They shout aloud and are like sacrificial bowls at the corner of the altar.

V16, The Lord their God saves the sons of Zion as the flock of His people. They are as the jewels of a crown and as an ensign upon His land.

V17, How great is His goodness and how great is His beauty. The corn of the Word make the young men full of life, and the new wine, of the life of Christ within, fills the young women with vitality.

Over the past three months, to today, 25.1.13, the Holy Spirit has been impressing on me, Zechariah 10:1,3-6, as well.

These verses of chapter 10 follow the same victorious theme of the verses from chapter 9.

Isaiah 59:19-21, Isaiah 60:1-5

V19, When the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard – a banner against him, says the Lord; (and put him to flight Amp.V). There are two possible translations, both very good.

V 20 And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, says the Lord.

V 21 As for Me this is My covenant with them says the Lord; My Spirit that is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth, Isaiah 51:16, shall not depart out of your mouth, nor out of the mouth of your children, nor out of the mouth of your children's children says the Lord, from henceforth and forever.

Isaiah 60:1 Arise and shine for your light has come and the glory of the Lord is risen upon you.

V 2 Darkness shall cover the earth and gross darkness the people: but the Lord shall arise upon you and His glory shall be seen upon you.

V 3 And the Gentiles shall come to your light and kings to the brightness of your rising.

V 4 Lift up your eyes roundabout, and see; all these gather themselves together, they come to you: your sons come from far, and your daughters shall be nursed at your side.

V 5 You shall see and flow together and your heart shall fear and be enlarged: because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto you, the wealth of the Gentiles shall come unto you.
