Jesus said it is **better for you that I go away**, for then I will send **the Enabler, the One Who empowers, the Guide, the Teacher, the Instructor, the Comforter, the Helper, the Holy Spirit** to you. John 16:7

Jesus said and **I will pray the Father and He will give** you another Helper, **Who will abide with you for ever**. John 14:16

He is **the Spirit of Truth** – You know Him for He is with you **and will be in you**. John 14:17

He will **guide you into all truth**. He is the Spirit of truth. John 16:13

He will **only tell you what He hears from the Father and the Son**. John 16:13

He will tell you **things to come**. John 16:13

He will glorify Me, **and pass on to you what is from Me and from the Father**. John 16:14, 15

This Jesus spoke about the Spirit, **Who those believing in Him would receive**, for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, for Jesus was not yet glorified. John 7:39

The Holy Spirit will convict the world of sin, righteousness and judgment

Of sin **because they do not believe in Me**; (this is the greatest sin and the root of all sin)

The Gospel is: Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved, Acts 16:31, Acts 26:18, --- from the eternal lake of fire--- Mark 9:42-48, Matthew 25:41, 46, Revelation 19:20, Revelation 20:10.

Of righteousness because **I go unto the Father**; (Jesus, the totally righteous One, ascended to the Father's right hand) By believing in Jesus we are made righteous, both imputed and imparted, justified and sanctified. 2Corinthians 5:21

Of judgment because the **ruler of this world is judged**. John 16:9, 10, 11. (satan was judged at the Cross, Heb 2:14, 1John 3:8, Colossians 2:15, Matthew 12:29, James 4:7; And the world will be judged by the Lord Jesus Christ at His second coming. Acts 17:31. And all believers will be judged by the Lord Jesus according to their works.

2Corinthians 5:10, Romans 14:10-12) (We are not saved by our good works, Ephesians 2:8, 9, but saving faith produces good works, Matthew 25:31-46, which prove that our faith in Christ Jesus was a genuine faith. James 2:14-25.)

When the day of Pentecost had fully come, the 120 disciples, men and women, (Acts 1:14, 15), **were all of one accord in one place, and suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind and it filled the place where they sat.
