Mix the Good News the Holy Spirit speaks to you, with Faith, And you will receive the Benefit. Hebrews 4:2

Hebrews 4:1-2 says, Let us fear, in case a promise being left us **of entering into His rest,** any of us should seem to come short of it. (*KJV with two words changed to make the sense clearer*).

For unto us was the Gospel preached, as well as unto them, (the nation of Israel in the wilderness), but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.

The rest that we enter into, by faith in the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, is the rest that we are living in Him, and He is living in us, and we are receiving, the benefits of all He has done for us and provided for us.

In our water baptism we are baptized into Christ and put on Christ. (Own words). Galatians 3:27.

We live in Christ. 2Corinthians 5:17.

Also, it is no longer I who live but it is Christ who lives in me. (Own words). Galatians 2:20.

He said come to Me and I will give you rest, and you shall find rest for your souls. Matthew 11:28, 29. (Own words).

Jesus said I am the Bread of life, come to Me; you will never hunger, believe in Me; you will never thirst. John 6:35. (Own words) Jesus said, I have come that you might have life, and have it more abundantly. John 10:10. (Own words).

Jesus said to the woman at the well, If you drink the water that I give, you will never thirst again. John 4:14. (Own words).

Through faith in Jesus Christ we have total provision for every need. This is rest of mind, soul and spirit and body.

Some examples of the Gospel Good News that brings us into this rest in Jesus Christ, (for a more complete list, go to 315 on the Numerical Index), is the truth that Jesus paid the price for our sins so that we can be forgiven and justified before God, and declared totally righteous in the sight of God the Father.

John 1:29, John 5:24, 1John 1:7, 1John 1:9, 1John 2:2, 1Corinthians 15:3, Ephesians 1:7, Romans 5:1, 2Corinthians 5:21.

The Gospel Good News is that Jesus Christ has defeated all of our enemies that seek to prevent us living a holy life unto God: sinful behaviour, Ephesians 4:22-24, Colossians 3:9,10, Romans 6:6, 11, 14, 22,

the devil, Hebrews 2:14, 1John 3:8, Colossians 2:15, James 4:7,

and the world system, , John 16:33, Galatians 1:4, Galatians 6:14,

that are opposed to us doing the will of God and living in fellowship with the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

The Good News of the Gospel is that Jesus Christ took all our weaknesses and infirmities bore all our sicknesses and diseases, and by the wounds on the Body of Jesus we were healed. Matthew 8:17, 1Peter 2:24, Psalm 103:3, James 5:14-16, Exodus 15:26, Psalm 107:20.

The Good News of the Gospel is that Jesus Christ had redeemed us from the curse of the law, Deuteronomy 28:15 -68, Galatians 3:13,14, and given us the blessing of Abraham, the promise of the Spirit by faith.

It is essential to know how to mix faith with this Good News, so that we receive the benefit promised. If we do not mix faith with the Good News, we can know it in our heads, but will never receive it and benefit from it.

As we read the Word of God, the Bible, each day, the Holy Spirit speaks to us. John 10:27, John 14:26.

The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit love us.

They know our need.

So the Holy Spirit draws our attention to a specific Scripture which stands out to us.

This is our spirit hearing the voice of God. Galatians 3:5, "the hearing of faith".

God is giving us a revelation of His Word, to enable us to increase our faith, so we can receive the grace and blessing of God.

It is by faith we receive the blessings of God.

Believing the Word in the heart, and proclaiming it out aloud, is the process of faith.

Deuteronomy 30:11-14, Psalm 1:2, (the word "meditate" means to speak or talk), Psalm 116:10, Romans 10:6-10, Hebrews 3:1, Hebrews 4:14, Hebrews 10:23, 2Corinthians 4:13. If the word "confession" or "profession" is used it means to say the same as God is saying.

The creative power of God is in His Word, (God said, "Let there be..." and it was. Genesis 1:3, 6, 9, 14.), and as we believe the Word God has spoken to us, and proclaim it out aloud, God will fulfil His Word and bring it to pass. 2Corinthians 4:13. "I believe, therefore I have spoken, and this is the Spirit of faith." God is always watching over His Word to perform it. Jer 1:12.

In my experience, after God has spoken to me, I proclaim the Word for about two weeks, day and night, and then I see the fruit of faith appearing. Mix faith with the Good News and it will become a reality to you.
