This is such a vital issue at this time. It is a number one priority.

To live in the Holy Spirit we need a strong relationship link with God the Father and the Son, where we are hearing His voice. God has chosen you and me for this. Acts 22:14, 15

Jesus said, "Watch, (keep alert in God), and pray always, that you may be counted worthy to escape all the terrible things that are coming on the earth, and to stand before the Son of God." Luke 21:36. (in my own words.)

We cannot survive as children of God, progress, nor fulfil God's will for our lives, unless we have an ongoing and a growing prayer relationship with God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit.

Instead of less time in prayer, we need more time in prayer!

As many as are led by the Holy Spirit, they are the sons of God. Romans 8:14

We must grow up in God to the place where we are hearing His voice all the time. John 10:27. My sheep hear My voice.

Do not let busyness nor business, distractions, hobbies, sport, entertainment, nor the desire to earn money, hold you back.

If you do not have any time to pray at all, because of the situation you are in, cry out to God right where you are and keep calling on Him. "Help me Lord to be close to You. I need You now Lord. Come and help me Lord Jesus." Romans 10:13, Psalm 34:6, 17
Keep your mind on the Lord and His Throne as much as possible. Colossians 3:1-3, Hebrews 12:2

You are seated together with Him in heavenly places, that is, in His Throne. Ephesians 2:6

He is beside you now. He will hear. He will answer you.

Jesus has called you to rule in life, not to be ruled by the circumstances you are in! Romans 5:17

Sort a few things out so that you have time to pray, if at all possible. "Praying without ceasing." 1Thessalonians 5:17

Jesus told a parable in Luke 18:1- 8, in which he urges us to pray always, and not to lose heart or give up.

If the persistent cry of the widow, moved the unjust judge to act on her behalf, how much more will God hear the cry of His own chosen ones, who cry out Him day and night. Jesus said, "I tell you He will avenge them speedily."

(He has chosen you to be His and to hear His voice. John 15:16, Acts 22:14, 15, Ephesians 1:4, 1Peter 1:2.)

God will hear and answer our prayer.

John 16:23, 24, John 14:13, 14, Mark 11:24, John 15:16, Matthew 7:7,8-11, Luke 11: 5-13, 1John 5:14, 15, Psalm 34: 4, 6, 17.

One day I was jogging in the city of Whangarei, in Northland, New Zealand, and the Lord Jesus began jogging beside me. The Lord Jesus spoke to me the words of John 16:23, 24.

"In that day-(when you see Me after I have risen again)- you will ask Me nothing, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever you ask the Father in My Name, He will give it to you. Hitherto-(up until now)- you have asked nothing in My name: ask and you will receive, that your joy may be full." John 16:23, 24

Praying in tongues is a great help. "For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prays, but my understanding (or my mind) is unfruitful." 1Corinthians 14:14.

In the busyness of life you can pray in tongues a lot of the time.

"He that speaks in an unknown tongue edifies himself, (builds himself up in the Holy Spirit)." 1Corinthians 14:4

Your spirit man within, Romans 7:22, 2Corinthians 4:16, is strengthened as you pray in tongues.

Playing worship CDs, as you are working around, will help and inspire prayer. It may be possible to use an MP3 and ear plugs.

Singing Scripture choruses, songs of worship, proclaiming Scripture verses that the Holy Spirit has made alive to you, will help. The joy of praising God through His Word is our strength. Nehemiah 8:10, Jeremiah 15:16

The Lord is with you. Hebrews 13:5, 6. He will help you. Draw on His grace. His grace is sufficient for you and His strength is made powerful in your weakness. 2Corinthians 12:9.
