Hebrews 9:14. **“How much more shall the Blood of Jesus Christ, Who, through the Eternal Spirit, offered Himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the Living God.”**

Some believers in the Lord Jesus Christ are troubled from time to time by thoughts of guilt, condemnation, and shame with the remembrance of past sins and disobediences and failures.

Satan is “the accuser of the brethren”, and is ever seeking to bring us into condemnation, shame and guilt. Revelation 12:10. He does this to discourage us, make us feel guilty and condemned.

But the truth is that the Blood of Jesus has justified us before God, and God sees us spotless in His sight, as we confess our sins, turn from our sins, surrender to Jesus as our Lord and Master, and trust in the Blood of Jesus to cleanse us from all and every sin. Romans 5:9, 1John 1:7, 9, Revelation 1:5, Ephesians 1:7, Colossians 1:14, Romans 3: 23, 24, 25.

So we overcome him, (satan), by the Blood of the Lamb. (By faith, we overcome all satan’s accusations, by the Blood of Jesus.) We overcome him, (satan), by the word of our testimony, (about the power of the Blood of Jesus). And we overcome him, (satan), by the grace of God, as we love not our lives unto the death. Revelation 12:11, Revelation 2:10. (This means, that by the grace that God gives to us, as believers in Jesus Christ, we hold faithful to Jesus when our life is threatened or taken from us.) Matthew 10:28.

The psalmist, David, cries out to the Lord, **“Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions.”** Psalm 25:7.

The Lord, Almighty God says, “Fear not; you shall not be ashamed: neither shall you be confounded-frustrated; for you shall not be put to shame: **for you shall forget the shame of your youth**, and shall not remember the reproach of your widowhood any more.” Isaiah 54:4.

The Lord says, “I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake, **and I will not remember your sins.**” Isaiah 43:25.

The all powerful Blood of Jesus, **washes and cleanses us** from all our sins, as we repent and believe the Gospel. Revelation 1:5.

The all powerful Blood of Jesus, **justifies us**, as we repent and believe the Gospel, so that when God looks at us He sees us just as if we had never sinned. Romans 5:9.

The all powerful Blood of Jesus, **sanctifies us**, and sets us apart from all evil unto God. Hebrews 13:12. (A few years ago, in a high dependency hospital ward, coming out of recent anaesthetic, and major surgery, I saw the angel of death coming for me, but as I declared the Blood of Jesus and resisted him, the angel of death turned around rapidly and fled.)

The all powerful Blood of Jesus, **redeems us**, from the controlling power of the world, the flesh and the devil. God has redeemed us or purchased us, by the precious Blood of Jesus, to belong to Him.

We are not our own, we are God’s property.
