As we read the Word of God, The Holy Spirit draws our attention to certain words and phrases. Isaiah 55:2, 3, 6, 10, 11.

This is “**God speaking to us through His Word.**” Psalm 119:49, 50, 105, 130, John 10:27, 28, 1John 2:27, John 14:26.

Jesus said, “**Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word that comes from the mouth of God.**” Matthew 4:4.

“Faith comes by **hearing**, and **hearing** by **the Word of God.**” Romans 10:17.

When God speaks to us He is giving us faith. This is the hearing of faith. Galatians 3:5.

This is how God has decided we are to live. “The just shall live by faith.” Romans 1:17.

**And this is a continuous, ongoing, never ending process of believing what God has said to us. It is not a one off event.**

**We must keep on, (believing and), enduring to the end to be saved.** Matthew 24:13, Mark 13:13.

**We receive life from God as we believe in our heart what God says to us, and confess it out aloud before God and man and act on the Word wherever possible.** Romans 10:10, James 2:17, 20.

Jesus said, “He who has ears to hear, let him go on hearing.” Matthew 13:9.

When we are “born again”, John 3:3, 5, God gives us “ears” to hear His voice, so that we can live in fellowship with Him, walk in His ways, and obey His will.

**Righteousness and salvation** are two of the essentials of the Christian life. Romans 10:8-10, Isaiah 51:5, 6, 8.

When we believe in Jesus Christ as our Lord and Saviour, and believe and obey the Word He speaks to us, we are in a **right relationship** with God.

We are justified and declared righteous in His sight.

Genesis 15:6, Acts 16:31, Romans 5:1, Romans 5:9. Romans 10:6-10, 2Corinthians 5:21, 2Corinthians 7:1, 1John 3:7,

Confessing out aloud what God has said to us, before God, and before people when necessary, releases **salvation** into our lives. Romans 10:10, Matthew 10:32, 33, 28, Hebrews 10:23, Mark 11:23, Hebrews 3:1, Hebrews 4:14.

**Salvation** is receiving God’s mercy, grace, and truth, to live in this life, through faith in our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and His Word and promises.

It is freedom from, evil, harm and danger. Luke 1:69, 71, Mark 4:35-41.

It is deliverance from sickness and disease. Mark 1:29-31, Mark 1:32-34, Mark 2:1-12.

It is deliverance from demons. Matthew 8:16, Mark 1:21-28, Luke 4:40, 41.

It is deliverance from eternal death, given to those who repent and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ. Acts 4:12, 16:31.

It is deliverance from the bondages of sin. Romans 6:6, 11, Philippians 2:12, 13, Hebrews 2:3.

It is deliverance from the wrath of God at the Second Coming of Jesus Christ our Saviour. 1Thessalonians 5:1-10.

It is the sum of all the blessings of God, to us, through Jesus our Saviour. 2Corinthians 6:2, Jude 3.
