4. **The Ox Cherub**, Christ serving, *Rev 4:7*.
5. **Gospel of Mark – Jesus the Servant**.
6. **Written for the Roman world**.

1. **Truth, wisdom, knowledge**, understanding, revelation, word of knowledge, word of wisdom, discernment of spirits, prophecy, tongues, interpretation of tongues.
2. **Self worth** – Knowing how much God loves me.
3. **Crooked made straight**, *Lk 3:4-6*.
4. **The Man’s Face Cherub**, *Rev 4:7*. Eternal humanity of Christ, Son of Man
5. **Gospel of Luke – Jesus as the Perfect Man**
6. **Written for the Greeks and Gentiles**

1. **Righteousness, justice**, integrity, reliability, honesty, faithfulness.
2. **Identity** – who I am in Christ.
3. **Rough made smooth**, *Lk 3:4-6*.
4. **The Flying Eagle Cherub**. Divinity of Christ, *Rev 4:7*, Son of God.
5. **Gospel of John – The Divine Son of God**, *Jn 8:58*.
6. **Written for the Church**, *Jn 20:31*.

1. **Authority**, rule, reign, government, control, influence, leadership, **power**, ability, might, strength, to preach Christ, witness, heal the sick, cast out demons, work miracles of God’s power as in *Lk 7:22*.
2. **Significance**, my importance in God’s purposes.
3. **Valleys filled**, *Lk 3:4-6*.
4. **The Lion Cherub**, Christ ruling, *Rev 4:7*.
5. **Gospel of Matthew – Jesus the King, the Messiah**.
6. **Written for the Jews**.

Key to the Diagram

1. **Related attributes of Christ that are manifested in the believer** through faith in God’s promises. See “Pastors’ Notes,” No 115, pages 2,3.
2. **Four basic needs of every person** met in Christ through faith. See “Pastors’ Notes” Nos 25,91,127.
3. **Christ living in us prepares the way of the Lord**, as we believe the Word, *Lk 3:4,5,6*. See “Pastors’ Notes” Nos 80,154.
4. **The four cherubim who lead the worship of Christ** around God’s Throne, reveal the attributes of Christ, *Rev 4:6,7,8,9, Rev 5:8,14, Rev 6:1,3,5,7, Ezk 1:5-25, 10:1-22 etc*. See “Pastors’ Notes,” No115, pages 2,3.
5. **Which Gospel**, and the aspect of Christ focused on. “What the Bible is All About.” – Henrietta C. Mears.
6. **For whom the Gospels were written**. “What the Bible is All About” – Henrietta C. Mears. She explains how each of the four Gospels was written to reach one particular people group, Matthew for the Jews, Mark for the Romans, Luke for the Greeks and John for the Church and all believers.
